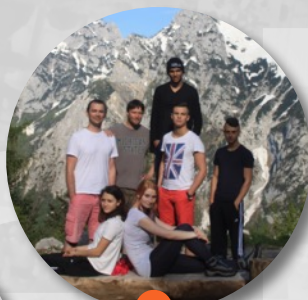

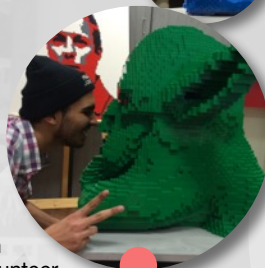
We take part in the "Play well. Play together." project.

20-26 May



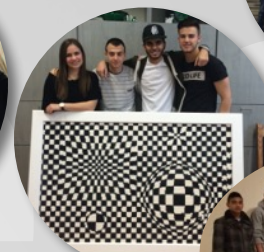
We build our first 3D sculpture designed by the American brick artists David Tracy and Ben Greenlee.

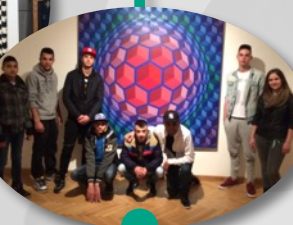
